

Drought Discount —

Spinning Your Wheels —

Study the bull sale advertisements in any beef publication and you will quickly see that nearly all of the bulls being offered have been bred and selected to help you increase your production per cow (weaning weight). This has been the primary focus of the beef industry for over 50 years. Seedstock producers continue to select for higher and higher growth EPDs, and for bigger and bigger weaning weights.



Seedstock producers have been able to increase their weaning weights because they are willing to spend whatever it takes to get the results they want. They can justify spending the extra money because commercial producers like you are willing to pay big bucks for their fat, overfed, high-input bulls. This is a ruse many seedstock producers have mastered.

Here's the rub... According to university research, there has been *NO significant increase* in weaning weights in commercial cowherds since 2001. Commercial cow-calf producers cannot justify spending extra money to get the results they were promised because they never get paid enough for those extra pounds to cover the cost of the extra pounds.

As a result of the beef industry's incessant selection for bigger and bigger weaning weights, cow size has increased 40% in the last 50 years. This increase has been gradual enough that it went unnoticed by most cow-calf producers. Noticed or not, the increase in cow size is real! This increase in cow size has resulted in lower stocking rates, higher production costs and reduced profits.

Allow me to spell this out for you... While cow size has continued to increase for the last 20 years, weaning weights have remained the same. Cow-calf producers are spinning their wheels. Forward progress is no longer possible. They are spending more to get less. This should come as a rude awakening — and it should create a change in thinking! Unfortunately, change comes mighty slow to cow-calf producers. Sometimes, it comes too late to do any good.

While everyone else has been focused on increasing production per cow (weaning weight), Pharo Cattle Company has been focused on helping you increase production per acre — which is much more profitable! Increasing production per acre involves a substantial increase in stocking rates with moderate-sized, low-input cows that can wean a higher percent of their own body weight.


Many cow-calf producers, however, are reluctant to use our low-maintenance bulls because they're afraid their weaning weights will decrease. That's a valid concern — but just the opposite usually takes place. It's not uncommon for our customers to produce bigger calves with our low-maintenance bulls than they were producing with the high-growth bulls they had been using. This happens because calves sired by our bulls do a much better job of fitting the environment. We won't cheat you on pounds; we will just put those pounds in a different package.

As time goes on... our customers are able to replace their big, high-maintenance cows with smaller, low-maintenance cows. Most producers are able to increase their stocking rate by over 30% with the right size and type of momma cows. Although these smaller cows will be weaning smaller calves, they will be producing substantially more pounds per acre — and those pounds will be worth more per pound. More pounds that are worth more per pound seems like a no-brainer!

No Shortage —

As you are studying all the bull sale ads in all the beef publications you receive, you will also notice there will be no shortage of fat, overfed, high-input Diesel Bulls to choose from this spring.

Most will be guaranteed to melt and fall apart when you take them home. Most will be guaranteed to produce late-maturing, hard-keeping replacement females. Most will not increase your weaning weights because their calves will not fit your environment. Most will cost much more than they are worth!

The Hidden Problem with... Testing Bulls for Feed Efficiency — By Kit Pharo

More and more seedstock producers are using GrowSafe equipment to measure and compare feed efficiency in the bulls they sell. On the surface, this seems like a very simple and accurate way to test and compare animals for feed efficiency. There is one very important fact, however, that most people totally ignore. This fact throws a big monkey wrench into the entire process of testing bulls for feed efficiency.



FACT: Producing a pound of Fat requires <u>2.5 times more feed</u> than producing a pound of Muscle or Bone.

As a result of this fact, all feed efficiency tests that measure intake and gain will heavily favor tall, lean, late-maturing animals that lack the propensity for fleshing ability. They perform best in a test like this because they are gaining pounds of muscle and bone — instead of fat. Fat deposition, for the most part, won't begin until they are older and bigger.

In contrast, moderate-sized, early-maturing, easy-fleshing animals will appear to perform very poorly in a test like this because they stop growing up and start storing up energy in the form of fat at a much younger age. Since it takes 2.5 times more feed to produce a pound of fat than it does to produce a pound of muscle or bone, these bulls will have a much lower rate of gain.

Terminal or Maternal... Testing bulls for feed efficiency makes sense if you have a terminal program in which *all* of your calves are sent to the feedlot — and no heifers are kept as replacements. However, if you produce your own replacement females, buying bulls that performed well in a feed efficiency test will do more harm than good.

If you produce your own replacement females, you need moderate-sized, early-maturing animals that are very easy fleshing. Fertility is more a function of fleshing ability than of anything else. Reproduction cannot take place until the heifer or cow is storing up energy reserves in the form of fat. Fat deposition is critical in this business!

Are You Tired...of Buying Bulls that Fall Apart?

If you are tired of buying bulls that fall apart when you take them home, you need to STOP purchasing high-maintenance bulls that are developed (fattened) on a high-energy ration.

High-maintenance bulls require too much feed to stay in decent condition. Fat bulls have nowhere to go but down. They will do good just to make it through their first breeding season.

Pharo Cattle Company specializes in thick, easy-fleshing, low-maintenance bulls that are developed *without* grain. They won't be as big or as fat as everyone else's bulls, but they will not melt and fall apart.

Because of the way our bulls have been bred and developed, they can breed twice as many cows for twice as many years as bulls coming out of other programs.


