Joel calls himself a Christian libertarian environmentalist capitalistic lunatic farmer. He co-owns, with his family, Polyface Farm in Swoope, Virginia. Featured in the New York Times bestseller *Omnivore's Dilemma* and award winning documentary *Food Inc.*, the farm services more than 5000 families, 50 restaurants and 10 retail outlets and a farmers market with salad bar beef, pig-aerator pork, pastured poultry, and forestry products. Salatin is the editor of the Stockman Grass Farmer and granddaddy catalyst for the grass farming movement.
